Wall Street Journal: **NORTH CAROLINA A&T STATE UNIVERSITY** Is No. 1 Public HBCU in America

New national rankings from the Wall Street Journal of America's top 500 universities recognize North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University as the nation's No. 1 public historically Black university. The Wall Street Journal/College Pulse rankings evaluate "how well each college sets graduates up for financial success ... how much a school improves students' chances of graduating and their future earnings," WSJ says. "We don't measure reputation, nor the college's own finances."

The rankings include 14 HBCU campuses, eight of them public. Trailing N.C. A&T among public campuses are, in order: Florida

A&M University, North Carolina Central University, Prairie View University, Tennessee State University, Savannah State University, Jackson State University and Alcorn State University.

On the private side, Spelman led all campuses, followed by, in order, Tuskegee University, Howard University, Xavier University of Louisiana, Morehouse College and Clark Atlanta University.

A&T is among 13 North Carolina campuses included in the rankings, led by, in order, Davidson College, Duke University and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. A&T and UNC-CH are among nine ranked UNC system campuses.

The officially licensed bobbleheads are being produced by the National Bobblehead Hall of Fame and Museum, an official licensee of Florida A&M University.

"Bobbleheads are the ultimate way to celebrate a team's championship, and these bobbleheads will be the ultimate way for Rattlers fans to commemorate FAMU's 2023 HBCU National Championship," National Bobblehead Hall of Fame and Museum co-founder and CEO Phil Sklar said. North Carolina A&T State University, Merck Introduce High School Students to **BIOTECHNOLOGY**

North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University and Merck (NYSE: MRK), known as MSD outside of the United States and Canada, hosted a five-day biotechnology camp for 12 high school students at the Merck Biotechnology Learning Center located at the Gateway Research Park South Campus.

The camp is a result of N.C. A&T's and Merck's ongoing partnership efforts to provide teaching, research and engagement opportunities not just to faculty and students on campus, but to young scientists in the local community.

Specifically, the students learned how to express, purify and analyze recombinant proteins through hands-on activities for a guided research project and as parallel, they participated in professional development activities that introduced them to biotechnology careers.

"I believe that the camp helped the students learn more about the biotechnology industry, in general, and biochemistry/molecular biology, in particular," said Nathan F. Simms Distinguished Professor Robert H. Newman, Ph.D., in A&T's College of Science and Technology (CoST). "They were introduced to concepts and techniques that they can build on in the future as they pursue careers in bioscience research ... Hopefully, the program will be a catalyst for the students as they continue to grow as researchers and as people."

BOARD APPROVES NORTH CAROLINA A&T UNIVERSITY B.S. IN ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE,

First of its Kind in North Carolina

AI

The University of North Carolina System Board of Governors has approved a bachelor's degree in artificial intelligence (AI) at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, the only degree of its kind in this state and one of only a handful nationally.

While some other North Carolina universities offer an artificial intelligence concentration within a computer science degree, North Carolina A&T will be the only institution with a stand-alone bachelor's degree. A&T's bachelor's degree in AI will help address this demand with a rigorous curriculum that covers foundational principles, advanced techniques and real-world applications of artificial intelligence, ensuring its graduates are ready for the workplace upon graduation.

Students will be able to enroll in one of two concentrations: Advanced AI Systems, offered through the College of Engineering (COE), and Applied AI in the College of Science and Technology (CoST). The concentrations offer flexible delivery formats including on-campus and online courses to accommodate diverse student needs.

Features Alabama State University Alumna/Staffer Concerning Breast Cancer Awareness





Alabama State University alumna and staff member, Dorothy Birl-Johnson (ASU class of 1986), was featured Oct. 2 on the hit nationwide Emmy-Award nominated daytime talk show, "The Jennifer Hudson Show."

Birl-Johnson, who works in the ASU President's Office as the administrative assistant to President Quinton T. Ross, Jr., appeared on the show to discuss the importance of breast cancer awareness and to encourage women of all ages to adopt the potentially life-saving practices of daily self-examinations and seeking immediate medical attention if they detect lumps or other abnormalities. Birl-Johnson has a personal interest in helping to spread the news about breast cancer. Her 26-year-old daughter, Eboni Faith Johnson (ASU class of 2020) died from the disease on July 2. Birl-Johnson appeared on Hudson's show along with her daughter, Angel Johnson Everett (ASU class of 2010), and her cousin, Wanda Williams-Madison (ASU class of 1999).

The family speaks at numerous public gatherings to enhance public awareness of breast cancer. Birl-Johnson said they are excited that their appearance on the Jennifer Hudson Show has now helped them to share their message with an audience of millions of viewers.
