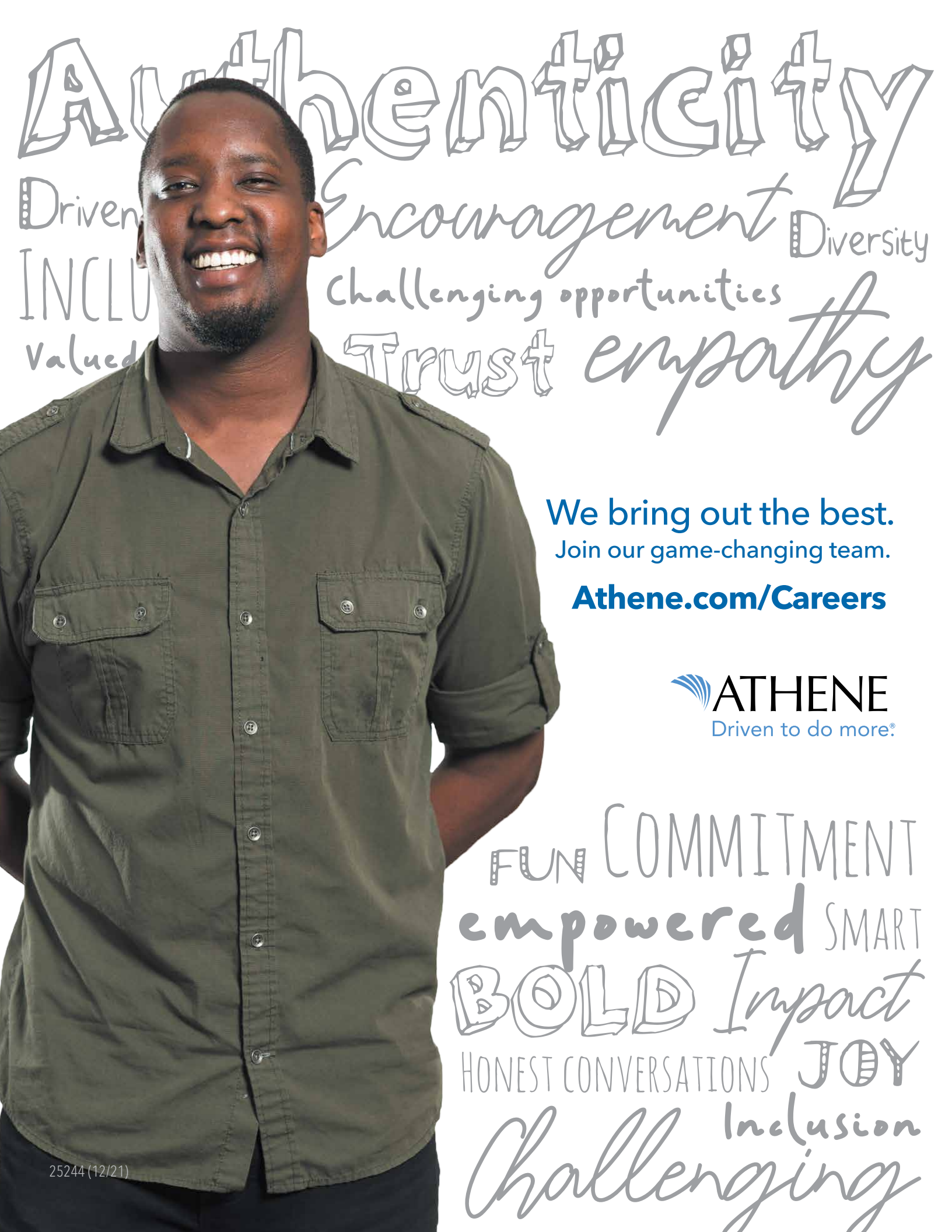

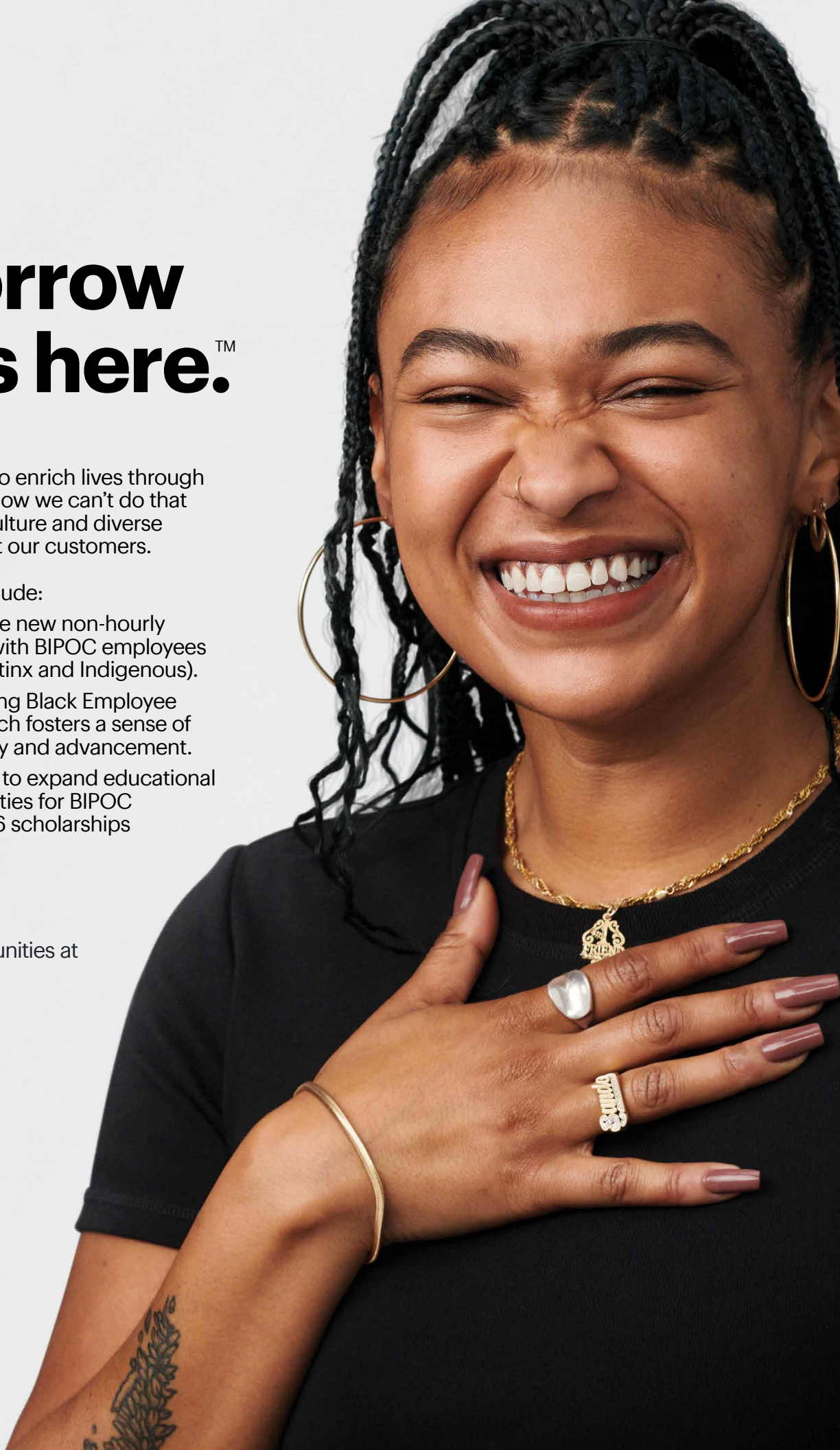

# THE HBCU BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION IS CHANGING THE GAME FOR HBCU ATHLETES

**T**here will soon be a new professional basketball league in town. (HBCUBA) will launch its inaugural season in 2023. The league will begin the season with teams from six states, Atlanta, Georgia, Birmingham, Alabama, Daytona Beach, Florida, Houston, Texas, Jackson, Mississippi, and New Orleans, Louisiana.

The HBCUBA was co-founded by Kimberly Meadows Clark and her partners. Clark's goal was to offer HBCU alums a chance to continue their careers and a space of their own. "It's like how players from Power 5 conference leave and go to the NBA", she explained. Because there is only one player in the NBA from an HBCU and only three in the NBA G-League, the new HBCU Basketball Association hopes to broaden professional opportunities for players who attend or attended one of our historic institutions.

According to Clark, the mission of the HBCUBA is to "Create opportunities and build legacies through the influence of basketball by investing in the HBCU community and culture. We will, at all times, display our values of integrity, compassion, justice, peace, and service in order to pioneer a Super Culture in sports, community, and business."

Clark will also lead the HBCUBA as League President. "It's an honor to join my partners in pioneering excellence." "We are big on history and culture, so we want the HBCU Basketball Association to be the league the Black Fives dreamed of and worked for. We want to bring our culture and legacy to life."

The league will be for players 18 years and older that are not currently in the NBA or G-League. The players must have attended an HBCU for at least one year or be presently enrolled in an HBCU. All players are compensated, and all games are live-streamed. The HBCUBA provides all players insurance, housing, transportation, uniform packages, profiles, and highlight videos. Teams will tour internationally, and the league is Eurobasket certified.

The 2023 season will begin on February 25th, 2023, and end on June 4th, 2023. For more information about the HBCUBA, including tryouts, go to [theHBCUBA.com](https://theHBCUBA.com).

The HBCUBA draft will be held on February 4, 2023, in Houston, Texas, with combines beginning in January 2023. Team names, coaches, and additional league staff will be announced in the coming weeks and months.

**H**BCU graduate a has been crowned Mrs. Universe 2022! The 45-year-old Tennessee native earned a Bachelor's degree in accounting from Tennessee State University, her master's degree in business administration, and a law degree from the University of Memphis. She is an attorney, actress, author, television producer, and a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. She currently lives in Singapore with her husband and two children.

Ingram has won several pageant titles, including Mrs. Indiana in 2007 and Ms. World International in 2012. She was the first African American to compete in both. Her other titles include Mrs. UK Universe 2013, Mrs. UK International 2014, and Mrs. Great Britain World 2011.

Ingram is the founder of Purpose Productions Inc., a production company that creates media by women, about women, but for everyone. In 2021, she launched a streaming platform, Purpose Streaming, dedicated to content that inspires, informs, and empowers through BIPOC-centric content.

The 2022 Mrs. Universe pageant took place August 21 – August 25 in Miami, Florida and more than 75 contestants participated from countries worldwide. As the reigning Mrs. Universe, Ingram will spend much of her time promoting Dress for Success, a global charity whose chapters she founded in Chattanooga, Tennessee, and the UK. The charity has chapters in 144 cities and 23 countries, and it economically empowers women across the globe.

"I am honored to win this title and grateful to my husband, children, family, friends, and pageant coach Kyle Ean Haggerty for believing in me and supporting me. Pageantry with purpose is powerful. Currently, I am working on a new special series titled 'Beyond Beauty' that will be released in late November, showcasing the Ms/Mrs pageant genre as well as the confidence-building and positive aspects of pageantry", said Ingram.

# HERE WE GROW AGAIN HBCUS CONTINUE TO EXPERIENCE RECORD ENROLLMENT

**C**ollege students have many options for education: PWI (predominantly white institutions), MSIs (minority-serving institutions), and HBCUs (historically Black colleges and universities). Fortunately for our community, more students are opting to attend HBCUs than ever before. HBCU enrollment has seen a steady incline since 2020. Some attribute the spike to the Black Lives Matter movement, while others would maintain that Black unity has become more of a focus due to the nation's political climate. For whatever reason, our beloved institutions are growing.

Fisk University, an elite private HBCU in Nashville, Tennessee, reported a remarkable enrollment increase over the past four years. In 2017, the total student body numbered 630 students. Fall of 2022, the student body exceeded 1,050.

Elizabeth City State University, a public HBCU located in Elizabeth City, North Carolina reported a significant increase in 2022 student body enrollment. The student body has increased by more than 52% over the last five years. Fall of 2022, the university reported the highest student count in eight years. The total university enrollment is 2149, nearly a 5% increase over 2021.

Fayetteville State University is a public HBCU located in Fayetteville, North Carolina. In the fall of 2022, the university reported its largest enrollment in over 20 years. The school's total enrollment for the fall semester was nearly 7,000 students. The school also welcomed its largest first-year, the first-time freshman class of 760 students, a 130-student increase over 2021.

North Carolina A&T University is a public HBCU in Greensboro, North Carolina. The university has the largest student body population in the country among all HBCUs. This fall, enrollment has grown to 13,530, the largest ever for a historically Black college or university. Its current plan revised that goal to 14,000 by fall 2023.

So, what does the increase in HBCU enrollment mean for the future of our communities? More HBCU students mean more HBCU graduates who will go on to become business owners, politicians, doctors, lawyers, scientists, instructors, actors, writers, media personalities, music moguls, and the list goes on and on. The future looks bright for HBCUs and the students they educate. We love to see it!

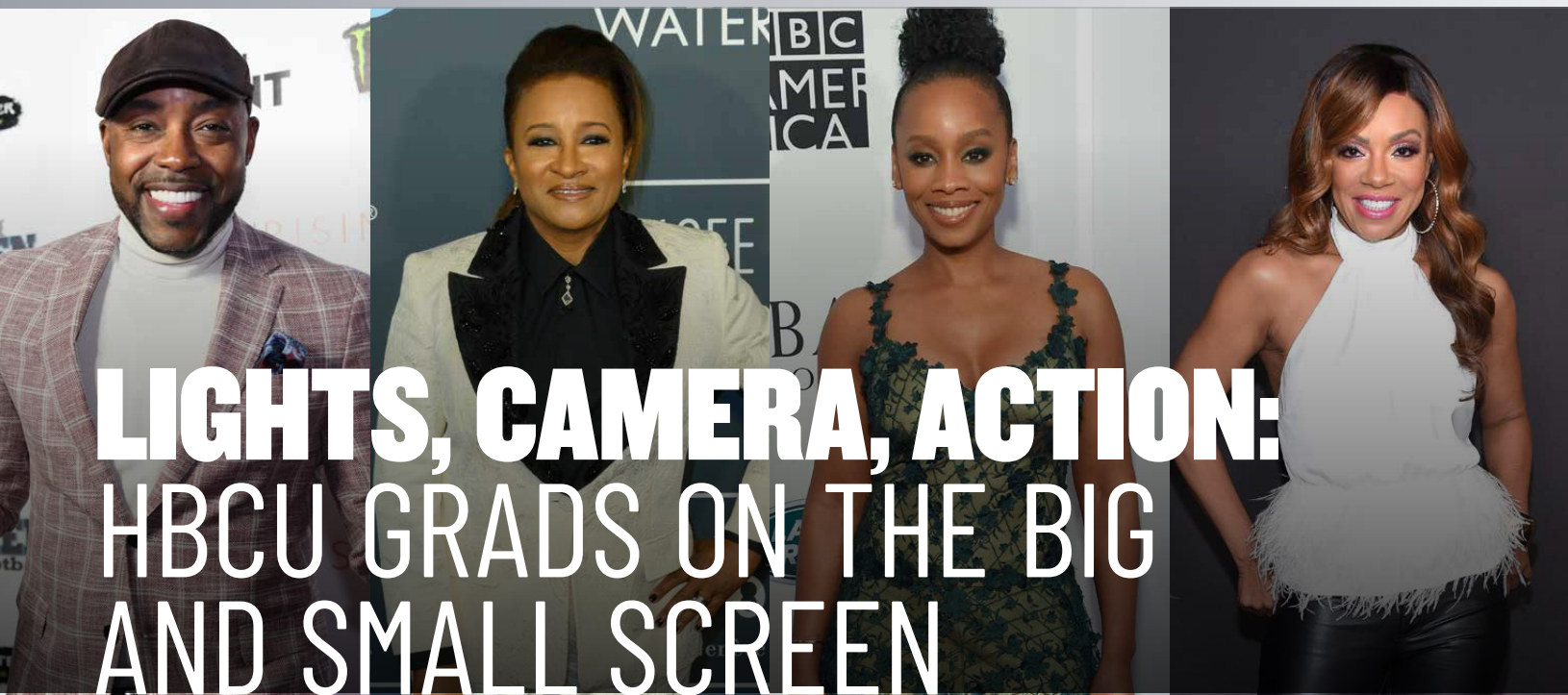

# PRESIDENT JOE BIDEN'S STUDENT LOAN FORGIVENESS

**T**he U.S. Department of Education (Department) announced a final extension of the pause on student loan repayment, interest, and collections through December 31, 2022. Borrowers should plan to resume payments in January 2023. While the economy continues to improve, COVID cases remain elevated. The President has made clear that pandemic-related relief should be phased out responsibly so that people do not suffer unnecessary financial harm.

To address the financial harms of the pandemic by smoothing the transition back to repayment and helping borrowers at the highest risk of delinquencies or default once payments resume, the Department will provide targeted student debt cancellation to borrowers with loans held by the Department of Education. Borrowers with annual income during the pandemic of under \$125,000 (for individuals) or under \$250,000 (for married couples or heads of households) who received a Pell Grant in college will be eligible for up to \$20,000 in debt cancellation. Borrowers who met those income standards but did not receive a Pell Grant will be eligible for up to \$10,000 in relief. The Department will announce further details on how borrowers can claim this relief in the weeks ahead. The application will be available no later than when the pause on federal student loan repayments terminates at the end of the year. Nearly 8 million borrowers may be eligible to receive relief automatically because relevant income data is already available to the Department.

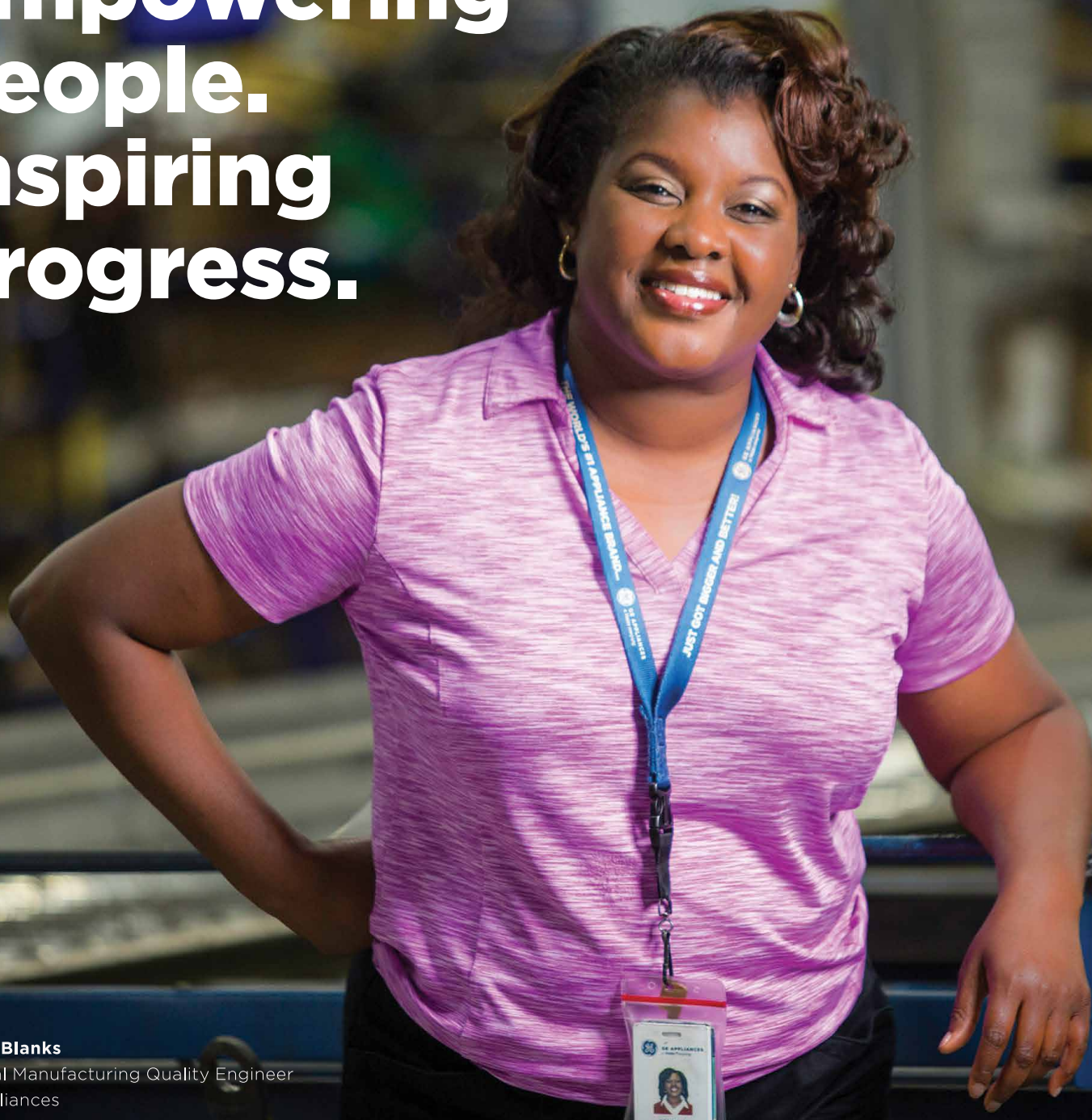

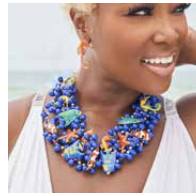
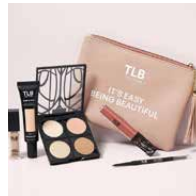
